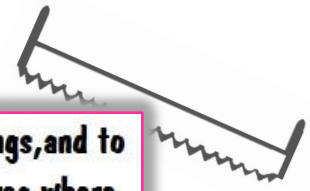
The Axe Women Loggers of Maine were **AMAZING** to work with, super responsive, and really engaged with our event - before, during, and after! Everyone loved having them!
